RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

Adelaide is home to the [South Australian Health and Medical Research Institute \(SAHMRI\)](#) - South Australia's first independent flagship health and medical research institute. SAHMRI is home to more than 800 medical researchers, working together to tackle the world's biggest health challenges.

Located a short distance from SAHMRI is Lot Fourteen, a creative and innovation precinct that is all about nurturing talent and driving jobs in some of the world's fastest growing industries. [Lot Fourteen](#) brings together industry, government and academia in a cross section of industries including space, defence and hi-tech. It is home to world-renowned global companies, start-ups and the Australian Space Agency.

Adelaide is also home to the [Tonsley Innovation District](#), a 61 hectare (150 acre) site where leading-edge research and education institutions, established businesses, and start-ups, business incubators, accelerators, government and the wider community come together to connect and collaborate.

PLANNING

Access

[Adelaide Airport](#) is a 10-minute drive to the city centre. A major upgrade of the airport is currently underway to expand its main terminal and upgrade international arrivals, departures and create more retail and dining options.

Accommodation

Adelaide offers over 5,000 accommodation rooms within 5 minutes' walk of the Adelaide Convention centre, with 6,500 rooms across the city Centre. An additional 1,600 new hotel rooms are due to come online in the coming years.

Key developments

In 2020, Adelaide welcomed the 329-room [Crown Plaza](#), Adelaide Oval's integrated 138-room hotel and [Eos by SkyCity](#) Adelaide the Adelaide Casinos' new 123-room hotel. Sofitel's five star 251-room property is due to open in 2021.
